




LINOCUT / RELIEF PRINTING


Making relief prints is a way for me to make affordable, accessible art for people to buy. The content is usually simple, direct, fun or relatable. Something which hopefully resonates with people instead of leaving them cold, as a lot of more avant garde art is prone to do.

The beauty of carving and printing by hand in this way is that each piece is unique, giving the owner the sense that each one is it's own piece of art, rather than a copy. For a reasonable price too.




ABSTRACTS




DIGITAL WORK

My digital work is largely experimental and leans heavily into some of my favourite tools – experimental typography, mixing hand-made and digital elements, and contrasting textures.


